LEESVILLE LAKE MAP

The Leesville Lake Association is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation that was formed in August 2003 to promote stewardship of Leesville Lake by (1) monitoring and protecting water quality, (2) assisting clean-up of waters and shorelines, (3) assisting in safe recreational use, (4) assisting in economic development and (5) fostering optimum water levels. The Association currently has 344 member-households and thirteen board members with representatives from all three counties surrounding the lake: Bedford, Campbell and Pittsylvania.

The Association is preparing a 20" x 27" full color map/brochure of Leesville Lake and the surrounding area. The map/brochure will contain a map and history of the lake, inset maps of the residential developments on the lake and a list of telephone numbers for accommodations, attractions, businesses, services and visitor information for the region.

The map/brochure will be made available for free. Advertising will pay for the cost of producing the map/brochure. Below is a list of advertising rates:

- Business card size (2" x 3.5") ad: \$200
- Half panel (4" x 3.5"): \$350
- Full panel (8" x 3.5"): \$650
- Text block (0.75" x 3.5") in telephone list: \$75
